EFFECTIVE: APRIL, 1995

POLICY

In order to maintain effective working relationships and a regular exchange of useful information with kindred organizations sharing the aims of the Institute, the President will appoint liaisons to such kindred organizations.

PROCEDURE

Appointment and Tenure

Appointments will be made annually for one-year, renewable terms that will begin on January 1 or on such other date as may be more convenient for the organization with which the liaison is maintained.

Relationship to the Board

Each liaison will be assigned to a member of the Board, through whom reports shall be provided at each national meeting of INFORMS.
